2021 Term 1 Staggered Finishes for Students – Information for Parents

- Parents/caregivers collect children from classroom or Prep collection point.
- NO COVID-19 Passes are required currently
- Due to social distancing requirements, gathering in groups on site or around school boundary is not permitted at any time. Maintain a physical distance of 1.5m between adults at all times. Movement through the school must be purposeful and direct.
- Parents/caregivers are not permitted on-site prior to 2.40pm on any day.

Q: What if a Prep child has an older sibling in Year 1 or 2?

A: Year 1 or 2 child will meet parents at their Prep sibling classroom at 2.40pm

Q: What if a Prep child has an older sibling/s in Year 3-6?

A: The Prep child will wait in their Prep classroom (with a teacher or teacher aide) until 3pm. The older sibling/s will join the Prep child in their Prep classroom. Parents/caregivers can collect both/all children at the Prep classroom at 3pm.

YEAR 1: Afternoon Pick Up – Finish time is 2.40pm

- Parents/caregivers collect Prep, Year 1 children at 2.40pm
- Parents/caregivers can collect their child from their classroom or a pre-arranged pick-up point with older siblings
- Teachers, teacher aides and school leaders will be present at the gates and around the school to support supervision and safety.

Q: What if my Year 1 or 2 child has an older sibling in Year 3 - 6?

A: The Year 1 or Year 2 child will wait in their classroom (with a teacher or teacher aide) until 3pm. The older child/ren will then meet at the youngest sibling's classroom at 3pm. Parents/caregivers can then collect their children from the Year 1 classroom at 3pm or they can walk together to meet their parents/caregivers at a pre-arranged meeting point on Currumburra Road or Warrawee Avenue.

Q: What if my child is catching a bus?

A: Your child will remain in their classroom until 3pm. They will be supervised by a teacher. They can then proceed to the supervised bus waiting area inside the school grounds.

Q: What if my child is going to After School Care (at Ashmore SS, PCYC or other)?

A: Your child will remain in their classroom until 3pm. They will be supervised by a teacher. At 3pm they can proceed to their After School Care area or pick-up point.

YEAR 2: Afternoon Pick Up – Finish time is 2.40pm

- Parents/caregivers collect Prep, Year 2 children at 2.40pm
- Parents/caregivers can collect their child from a pre-arranged pick-up point with older siblings
- Teachers, teacher aides and school leaders will be present at the gates and around the school to support supervision and safety.

Q: What if my Year 2 child has an older sibling in Year 3 – 6?

A: The Year 2 child will wait in their classroom (with a teacher or teacher aide) until 3pm. The older child/ren will then meet at the youngest sibling's classroom at 3pm. Year 2 and older siblings can walk together to meet their parents/caregivers at a pre-arranged meeting point on Currumburra Road or Warrawee Avenue.

Q: What if my child is catching a bus?

A: Your child will remain in their classroom until 3pm. They will be supervised by a teacher. They can then proceed to the supervised bus waiting area inside the school grounds.

Q: What if my child is going to After School Care (at Ashmore SS, PCYC or other)?

A: Your child will remain in their classroom until 3pm. They will be supervised by a teacher. At 3pm they can proceed to their After School Care area or pick-up point.

YEAR 3 – 6: Afternoon Pick Up – Finish time is 3.00pm.

- Parents/caregivers can collect Year 3 Year 6 children at 3.00pm.
- Parents/caregivers can collect children from their classroom or a pre-arranged collection point at 3.00pm
