Dear Parents/ Carers,

Ashmore State School operates a **Student Resource Scheme for 2023** to assist parents with the cost and resourcing of additional educational resources that provide enhanced learning opportunities.

The purpose of the scheme is to provide the parent/carer with a cost effective more economical alternative to purchasing required resources and consumables through reduced prices gained from the schools bulk purchasing processes. The provision of this scheme ensures that well-resourced learning by our students remains our key focus.

The Student Resource Scheme (SRS) operated in accordance with the section 51 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 and is endorsed annually by the schools P & C Association. The scheme is not used to raise funds for other purposes. The scheme provides the entire package for the specified participation fee and is not available in parts.

PARTICIPATION IN THE SCHEME

All parents/ carers are required to sign the application form indicating that they have read the terms and conditions outlined in this document and understand the contract conditions on the participation form.

If a student leaves the school during the year, a pro-rata will be made on the basis of a 40 week year.

NON PAYMENT

Anyone who fails to pay the full contribution will be excluded from the scheme and its associated recourses at the discretion of the Principal.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Option 1:

Full payment prior to Friday 24th March 2023- \$120.00

Option 2:

Instalments per child due by the end of the second week of each Term:

1st Instalment – Term 1 due 17th February 2023 \$50.00

2nd Instalment – Term 2 due 5th May 2023 \$40.00

3rd Instalment – Term 3 due 21st July 2023 \$30.00

You are required to complete the 'Student Resource Scheme Form' attached and return to the office as soon as possible. Please ensure you read the terms and conditions on the back of the form which is generic for all QLD primary and secondary schools. Payment arrangements are either in a lump sum or by 3 easy instalments.
