Our initiatives include

- Appointment of 2 x Directors of Teaching and Learning at 0.5 FTE each.
- Continue to utilise the distributive leadership model through Curriculum Support Team Advisors who will provide coaching and mentoring to teachers in pedagogical practice that supports the school's explicit improvement agenda, the schools 4 year Strategic Plan 2017-2020 and the DETE Strategic Plan 2015-2018.
- The appointment of a Deputy Principal/Curriculum to assist in building the curriculum knowledge of Ashmore State School staff within a growing school.
- 0.4 FTE Science Teacher to assist in building teacher capacity in pedagogical practice and enhancing student outcomes.
- Continue to implement the Link-It! Intervention program to deliver targeted intervention in literacy and numeracy to ensure students are provided with in-depth instruction and support at all levels of achievement.
- Continue the Pre-Prep Program to provide access to early childhood programs in readiness for formal schooling.
- Employ a 0.6 FTE Digital Technology/STEM teacher to continue implementation of Digital

- Technologies as per the Australian Curriculum and to upskill all staff in this subject area.
- Appointment of Teacher Aide as assistant in STEM and Digital Technology lesson.
Appointment of Teacher Aides in specialist subject areas to support teaching and learning that enhances Literacy and Numeracy skills.
- Expand and utilise ICT resources specifically selected to support an integrated approach to implementing ICT across the curriculum.
- Continue appointment of Early Childhood Director to introduce and coordinate school based playgroup.
